



Laminations in the thermal vacuum process Kaschierungen im Thermovakuumverfahren

Please read this **information!**

One possibility of lamination is the thermal vacuum process with „RagMount“ on various support materials up to a size of 90/120 cm. Unlike most plastic films RagMount remains permeable to air after installation. This type of lamination is specifically optimized for pigment prints, because the temperature during the pressing process remains under 75° C, and therefore there is no risk for the ink pigments to be damaged.

Quote of the Bienfang website:

„RagMount is a heat-activated adhesive with a 100% cotton rag tissue carrier. This is the only adhesive on the market did today is designed for dry mounting giclee prints. So it can be used in dry mounting digital prints to fine art paper and in traditional dry mounting applications.“

I laminate RC / PE prints, pigment prints, fine art prints and classic Baryte prints with RagMount on various materials, for example museum cardboard, solid aluminum, Dibond, acrylic, wood, etc.

The prices are based on museum cardboard acid-free with the specification, glued neutral and alkaline buffered (ANSI Z 39.48-1992, DIN 9706, DIN 6738).

Please request individual offer for variations on solid aluminum plates (up to 3 mm) with sawn edge for a frameless hanging. Even when working with the utmost care, no liability can be assumed for damaged prints.

For pricing purposes of the laminations; first of all there is the basic amount of work to be considered, so small sizes are relatively expensive. With respect to different medium and large sizes, the resulting price is influenced by the amount of metal cut-off that incurs. Moreover, I make exclusive use of high-quality materials that justify their price.

Another possibility of lamination:

Wet mounting (only practical with Baryte prints) on aluminum sandwich panels, linen or solid aluminum.

Edges require an extra charge depending on complexity. The Image must have approximately 4 mm oversize on each side.
